

Cookie Policy

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

Cookie	Name	Purpose
CloudFlare	_cfduid	This cookie is used to identify individual clients behind a shared IP address and apply security settings on a per-client basis.
Hotjar	_hjIncludedInSample	This cookie is used to collect information that helps us assess the performance of our website via 'heat maps' and recordings. This information is used to inform future website improvements.
HubSpot	Hubspotutk _hssc _hssrc _hstc	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use the website. We use this information to help us improve the website and to inform our direct marketing targeting. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, unless the visitor is included in GJE's marketing database, in which case website activity is recorded against that individual's name record.
Universal Analytics (Google)	NID _ga _gat _gid	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website. We use the information to compile performance reports and to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the website where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited.
